Intro

Colossians 2:6-15

Therefore, as you received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk in him, rooted and built up in him and established in the faith, just as you were taught, abounding in thanksgiving.

See to it that no one takes you captive by philosophy and empty deceit, according to human tradition, according to the elemental spirits of the world, and not according to Christ. For in him the whole fullness of deity dwells bodily, and you have been filled in him, who is the head of all rule and authority. In him also you were circumcised with a circumcision made without hands, by putting off the body of the flesh, by the circumcision of Christ, having been buried with him in baptism, in which you were also raised with him through faith in the powerful working of God, who raised him from the dead. And you, who were dead in your trespasses and the uncircumcision of your flesh, God made alive together with him, having forgiven us all our trespasses, by canceling the record of debt that stood against us with its legal demands. This he set aside, nailing it to the cross. He disarmed the rulers and authorities and put them to open shame, by triumphing over them in him.

· The Problem with Religion

- O True Faith requires belief in the God who created the universe Hebrews 11:1-3, 6
- o True godliness needs to power of God Himself 2 Timothy 3:1-5
- O Many people want benefits of religion, but without encountering the true God!
- O But without the power of God religion is worthless ... in that regard atheist right if there is no God then it is foolish, even dangerous to have religion!
- O But the God of the Bible, in addition to claiming the role of creator and God, also demands more than simply religion, rather he calls us to give him all our heart, soul, mind and strength ... transforming not just our 'religious practices but all of life!

• Application:

o Religion is utterly worthless without God, and vitally critical to all of life in light of God

2) Does Religion Meet Our Most Basic Need?

- How do religions describe our need?
- How do religions try to meet our need?
- What does the Bible say?
 - Need is not ...
 - o Need is ...
 - o Romans 5:6-11
 - o Bible is ONLY religious book that offers this drastic a statement of the problem and this amazing of a solution ... all other religions fall far short of true reconciliation to God

• Application:

- o Critical to first **define the need correctly** before we can ask what religions meet the need
- Once need is truly seen and felt, **no solution other than Jesus Christ** can come close to meeting it
- For self, and for reaching others, there can be no good news without grasping the bad news!
- o Fortunately, **God's Spirit is in the business of convicting** and showing people sin!

3) False Christianity

- Legalistic, self-made religion Colossians 2:22-23
- Permissive, worthless religion James 1:22-27
- Application:
 - o **2 hands illustration** Bible says both are connected, but connected in a specific order.
 - o "Christian" cults
 - o Look at our own heart and life

4) Authentic Christianity

- Seeing God for who He is
- Acknowledging our sin, rebellion and self-worship
- Coming to Jesus
- Seeking to live out of that redemption
- Offering all our lives in love of God ... and through Him in love of neighbor
- Trusting in God's promises
- Giving God all the glory
