• Eternal Life:

<u>In 3:16</u> "For God so loved the world, that he gave his only Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have **eternal life.**

<u>Jn 3:36</u> Whoever believes in the Son has **eternal life**; whoever does not obey the Son shall not see life, but the wrath of God remains on him.

<u>In 5:24</u> Truly, truly, I say to you, whoever hears my word and believes him who sent me has **eternal life**. He does not come into judgment, but has passed from death to life

<u>In 6:27</u> Do not work for the food that perishes, but for the food that endures to **eternal life**, which the Son of Man will give to you. For on him God the Father has set his seal."

<u>In 6:40</u> For this is the will of my Father, that everyone who looks on the Son and believes in him should have **eternal life**, and I will raise him up on the last day."

In 6:47 Truly, truly, I say to you, whoever believes has **eternal life**.

<u>In 6:54</u> Whoever feeds on my flesh and drinks my blood has **eternal life**, and I will raise him up on the last day.

 $\underline{\text{In } 10:28}$ I give them **eternal life**, and they will never perish, and no one will snatch them out of my hand.

<u>In 17:3</u> And this is **eternal life**, that they know you the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom you have sent.
